

NQHA Stallion Service Auction

Good to know for the **stallion owner**:

- The NQHA SSA does not require pre-payment. If the breeding is not sold, there is no investment.
- We will promote your stallion to our members and followers on the website and the Facebook page.
- 70 % of the paycheck in the futurity and maturity classes is paid to the rider/owner and 30 % to the nominator of the stallion. In that way, you will benefit from well-performing offspring as well.
- If the offspring is performing well in the futurity, this will be a nice promotion for your stallion.
- By supporting the SSA, you are assisting the NQHA with the mission to promote the American Quarter Horse.

Good to know for the **mare owner**:

- The SSA only auctions the breeding fee for the stallion. In most cases, there will be additional costs, for example to collect the semen or for shipment. These costs are paid to the stallion owner and the SSA is not involved.
- Order frozen semen well in advance. With this type of semen, it is particularly important to inseminate at the right time. Therefore, it has to be present at the veterinarian practice early. You will generally receive enough to inseminate twice. If you need more, there might be additional costs.
- Always contact the stallion owner in advance and ask about the costs of shipment or other fees. Many stallion owners work with contracts, so you can ask to read this before purchasing the breeding.
