- 1. Entryform
 - Entryforms need to be filled in online and send by email before the deadline. The organization reserves
 the right not to accept new registrations after the deadline. Additional fees will apply after the deadline.
 No photo's accepted.
 - All participants in L1 classes Amateur, Youth (exhibitors) & Open(horses) must be able to confirm there leveling status if requested by the showoffice. You can find your levelling status at https://aqhaservices.aqha.com/members/summaries/viewleveling.
 - By sending in the entryform each owner/exhibitors acknowledges the announcement and the general terms and conditions.
 - Please send a copy of the AQHA registration papers and AQHA membershipcard for the AQHA classes.
 And a copy of NSBA registration certificate and NSBA membershipcard rider and owner. If this is not complete the registration can not be processed. No exceptions are made.
 - The host is not responsible for lost email which have not arrived.
 - Every participant will receive an entry confirmation and updated information. Each participant is responsible to check this information. Every participant is responsible for being on time before the class starts.
- The host reserves the right to change the announcement until the entry deadline, change the date of show or cancel it if necessitated by certain circumstances. After the deadline, the final schedule will be published and might contain slight changes.

- 3. In case of cancellation after the deadline, with a valid reason and a doctor's or veterinarian's statement, only the box camping membership(s) and office charge will be charged. If the participant is unable to provide the said statement or has not cancelled in time, the full costs will be charged.
- 4. Each horse must be covered by liability insurance. If the participant is unable to provide the vaccination record must be clear that the horse has had a first/base influenza vaccination followed by a yearly repeated vaccination. The first/base vaccination followed by a second vaccination within minimum of 21 and maximum of 92 days. A vaccination needs to be given at least 6 days before the show.
- 5. Participation and attendance at the show is entirely at your own risk. Neither the Dutch Quarter Horse organization nor the organization nor the location accepts any liability for loss, damage or theft of your horse(s) and/or property, nor for any injury suffered or death of a participating and/or present horse, rider or visitor during the entire duration of the show/event.
- 6. Longeline and In Hand Trail is for 2 and 3 year old horses. A horse entering those classes may not be entered under saddle. Horses shown in In Hand Trail 4 & Older, the same rider/horse combination may not be entering trail classes under saddle.
- 7. If there are less than three entries for Select classes at the time of the entry deadline, the respective class will be cancelled and integrated in the respective Amateur class. The open classes are junior and senior, if there are less than 3 entries in one of the classes the classes will be held together as a all aged class.
- 8. AQHA & NSBA classes will be held class in class.
- 9. You must not lunge or ride on the showground without a valid entry number. The whole facility, especially the warm-up pen will be checked on unsportsmanlike behavior (Rulebook VIO200). Longeing is only allowed at the indicated places.

Arrival

Arrival on Thursday 13 june 2024 from 13.00. Not earlier, the stalls will not be ready. Stalls go in order of receiving of the registration form.

Openingstijden showoffice / Opening hours showoffice

The showoffice will be open Thursday 13 June 2024 from 16.00 – 18.30. On show days the show office is open 1 hour before the show start and closed at 18.00. Changes can be made till 16.00 the day before the class take place.

Luxembourg Champion

- The title of Luxembourg Champion in AQHA& NSBA open classes will be awarded to the horse. The horse owner must be a current QHAL member or a championship fee must be paid.
- Titles in AQHA & NSBA Amateur, Youth will be awarded to horse/rider combination. The rider must be a current QHAL Member or a championship fee must be paid.
- To determine a Luxembourg Champion all results of both judges will be valued. In case of a tie, the tie judge will decide. The points will calculated by the allround system.
